1 Request

2 Reply

The following information is taken from Tyne and Wear Fire and Rescue Service (TWFRS) Incident Recording System (IRS). An IRS incident record is completed by the Officer in Charge for every incident attended.

Unfortunately we do not store clutter image ratings (CIR) or victim details such as if they ex military data in our system. We also do not have a designated field in our database if emollient cream was used, this may get used in the incident commentary free text box.
